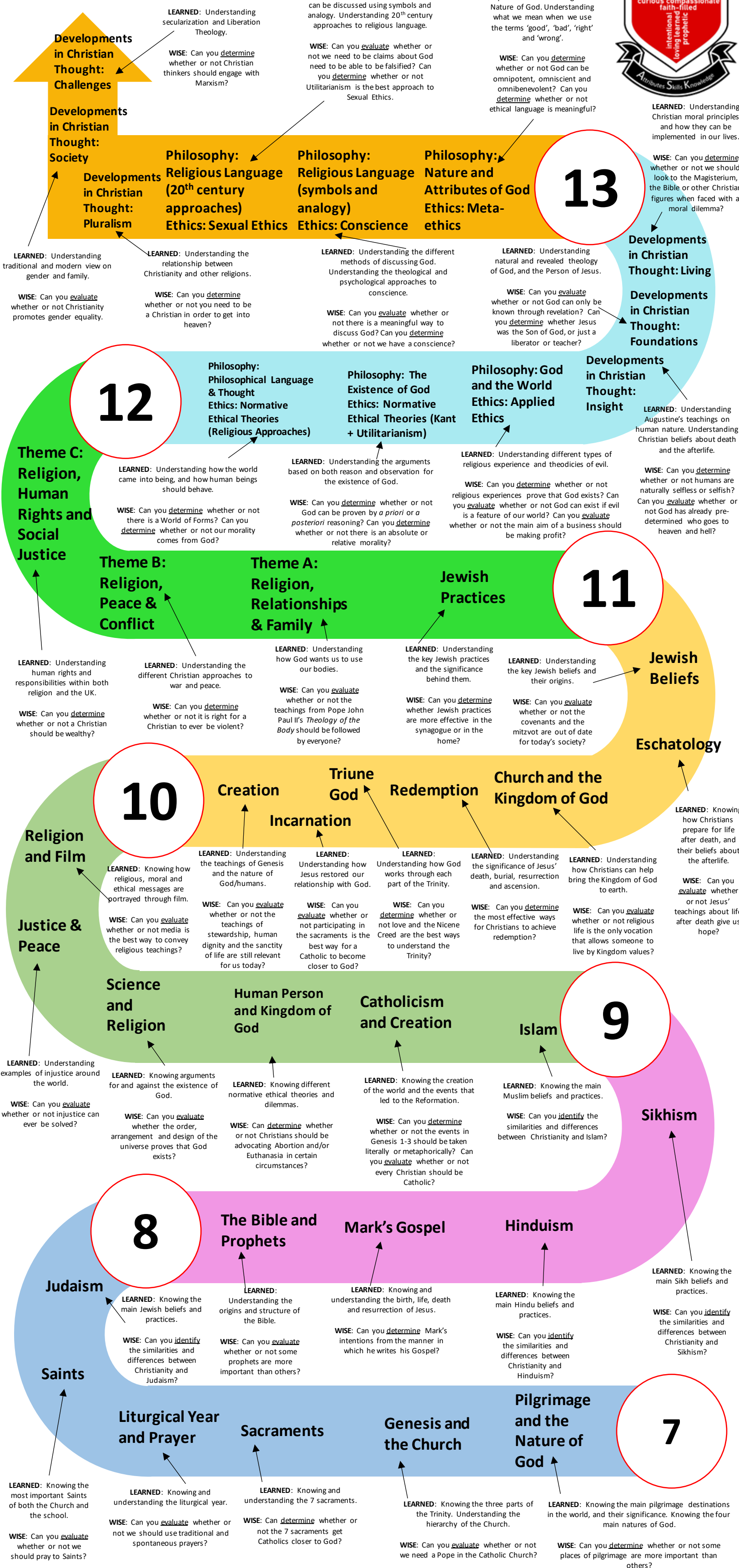


Department Intent: Bringing students to a personal knowledge and understanding of God, through the experience of Christ.



- Mastery at Year 13:**
- Considering what we mean when we use ethical terms.
 - Considering the most appropriate way to discuss God.
 - Applying pluralism, exclusivism and inclusivism to beliefs about death and judgement.
 - Comparing and contrasting Christianity to Liberation Theology and Marx.
- Mastery at Year 12:**
- Enhanced knowledge of normative ethical theories.
 - Introduction to key philosophers with arguments for and against the existence of God.
 - Increased case study examples relating to business and euthanasia and application of normative ethical theories.
 - Applying scholars to arguments for and against the existence of God.
- Mastery at Year 11:**
- Application of knowledge of the Catholic Church to modern ethical dilemmas.
 - Using Pope John Paul II's *Theology of the Body* to determine the best methods of approaching relationships.
 - Application of Mark's mindset to human rights and social justice.
- Mastery at Year 10:**
- Secure knowledge of the creation story and its impact on humanity.
 - Identifying the most effective ways to restore our relationship with God/
 - Ability to discuss biblical passages from a fundamentalist, conservative and liberal position.
- Mastery at Year 9:**
- Key concepts understood – stewardship, human dignity and the sanctity of life.
 - Secured knowledge of the Nature of God and humans.
 - Using that knowledge in debates relating to Abortion and Euthanasia.
 - Identifying effective ways to bring the Kingdom of God to earth.
- Mastery at Year 8:**
- Applying knowledge of key aspects of Mark's Gospel.
 - Knowledge of the main Old Testament prophets.
 - Ability to compare and contrast Hindu and Sikh beliefs with those of Christians.

- Praying to Saints for specific needs.
 - Locational knowledge- global and regional.
 - Key vocabulary relating Jewish beliefs and practices.
 - Key concepts of transience and eternity.
 - Developed knowledge of places of pilgrimage.
