Eligibility Criteria

To apply to the Apprenticeship Summer School, you must meet the following criteria:

- Attend, and have always attended, a state-funded, non fee-paying school/college.
- Be in Year 12 (England and Wales), Year 13 (Northern Ireland) or S5 (Scotland) at the start of the programme.

In addition, we are looking for students who:

- Have achieved at least five GCSEs at grades 9 – 6 (A*-B), including English and Maths. A minimum of two of these qualifications should be at grades 9 – 7. Or five A or B grades at National 5 including one A.
- Would be the first generation in their family to gain a degree/degree-level qualification.
- Have been eligible for Free School Meals whilst at secondary school.
- Live in a neighbourhood with a low rate of progression to higher education or a high level of socio-economic deprivation.
- Have attended schools with a lower than average progression to higher education, or a higher than average proportion of students who qualify for Free School Meals.
- Have been looked after or in care.

The more criteria you meet, the more likely you are to get a place on the programme. Not meeting all of the additional criteria will not disqualify you.
